

State of Wisconsin Identification Form for Truescreen Criminal History Check

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation, upon application, issues operator's licenses and identification cards to eligible Wisconsin residents. See, e.g., Wis. Stat. s. 343.14(1). Per Wisconsin statute 343.50(12)(e), individuals may not upload an image of a state issued identification cards from Wisconsin to Truescreen.

Individuals should upload a copy of their Wisconsin operator's license (i.e., Driver's License) or another government-issued photo ID (e.g., passport) for the Truescreen process, if one is available. If your only government-issued photo ID is a Wisconsin identification card, please complete and upload this form to Truescreen.
