What is AmeriCorps NCCC?

AmeriCorps NCCC is a national service program whose mission is to strengthen communities and develop leaders through direct, team-based national and community service. Within a full-time, residential setting, AmeriCorps NCCC members are assigned to a regional campus and placed onto teams of six to twelve members. Over the course of their 10-month service term, each team will complete a series of different projects in different places, with each project lasting three to 13 weeks.

AmeriCorps teams are comprised of 18–26-year-olds from diverse backgrounds. Following mission, diversity, and leadership training, teams and their Team Leader deploy to organization to prepared to strengthen communities participate in service-learning opportunities.

How do I prepare to host a NCCC team? Be a nonprofit organization with a need. Communicate your plan within your organization. Ensure you have 40 hours of work for a team of 8 to 12 corps members. Prepare a service-learning project work plan. Then, submit a concept form. We're here to help! Contact your local NCCC representative for more information.



What NCCC provides:

- 6-12 Corps Members and 1 Team Leader.
- One 15-passenger van and fuel.
- Limited funds, specifically designated for team food purchases.
- Limited hand tools and basic personal protective equipment (PPE).
- Federal Tort Claim Act and Federal Employees Compensation Act Coverage
- Service-learning training to build understanding of community needs and the organizations that support their communities.

What project sponsors provide:

- Planning and organizational orientation.
- Technical supervision (at least 20 hours per week).
- On-site technical training, supplies, and equipment.
- 40 hours of full-time service per week, per member, to include explanation of project value, community enhancement, and service learning.
- Housing for a team during the project (with bathroom/shower and cooking facilities (unless meals are provided)
 - Examples: Youth hostels, Churches, Community Centers, Campsites
- Parking for a 15-passenger van.
