

AmeriCorps NCCC Southwest Region at a Glance

AmeriCorps NCCC is a national service program whose mission is to strengthen communities and develop leaders through direct, team-based national and community service. Within a full-time, residential setting, AmeriCorps NCCC members are assigned to a regional campus and placed onto teams of eight to 12 members. Over the course of their 10-month service term, each team will complete a series of different projects in different places, with each project lasting three to 13 weeks. Members work on projects with sponsoring organizations to address local community needs in the areas of energy conservation, environmental stewardship, infrastructure improvement, natural and other disaster services, and urban and rural development.

92% believed their AmeriCorps NCCC team met the community's primary need completely or to a large extent.


89% believed to a large or moderate extent that the AmeriCorps NCCC team's efforts strengthened the local community.
