AmeriCorps NCCC, one of AmeriCorps' core programs, is a full-time, 10-11 month, service opportunity that covers all costs of participation, to include lodging and travel expenses, allowing young adults to serve on a team and make an impact in communities across the country while gaining valuable leadership and career skills.

Programs Serve as a Team Leader (ages 18+) or Corps Member (ages 18-26).



- Complete hands-on projects in a variety of areas
- Work alongside nonprofits, local and state government agencies, tribal organizations, and faith based groups



- Work with FEMA staff in an administrative capacity
- Support communities before, during, and after disasters
- Take a step toward federal employment



- Work on wildfire risk mitigation, reforestation, environmental conservation, and resource management
- Field based, rigorous work with the US Forest Service



- Returning in Summer 2025
- Streamlined version of NCCC's other programs, on a shortened timeframe (2-3 months).
- Projects may focus on environmental stewardship, climate change mitigation, affordable housing, other types of community-focused service activities

- Basic expenses, including communal housing, meals, a modest living stiped, and a limited health benefit
- All program-related travel, including to your training location, projects, and back home after your service term
- Forbearance for federally backed student loans
