What is AmeriCorps Seniors?

Nation's largest group of older **American** volunteers

One of the oldest programs in the National Service family

A set of three programs that empower older Americans (55+) to serve their communities

AmeriCorps Seniors Programs





Foster Grandparent Program (FGP)



RSVP Program



Senior Companion Program (SCP)

The Foster Grandparent Program (FGP)

- Role models and mentors to children with exceptional needs
- Help children learn to read and provide one-on-one tutoring
- Mentor troubled teenagers and young mothers
- Care for premature infants or children with disabilities
- Help children who have been abused or neglected
- Eligible volunteers may receive a small stipend to defray the costs of serving



The Senior Companion Program (SCP)

- Provide assistance and friendship to adults who have difficulty with daily living tasks, such as shopping or paying bills
- Help them remain independent in their homes instead of more costly institutional care
- Give other caregivers much needed respite
- Eligible volunteers may receive a small stipend to defray the costs of serving



RSVP Program



2019 Longitudinal Study



AmeriCorps Seniors Volunteers 84% reported improved or stable health

AmeriCorps Seniors Volunteers 88% reported a decrease in feelings of isolation

AmeriCorps Seniors Volunteers 78% reported they felt less depressed

Senior Demonstration Program (SDP)



- Expand program reach
 - Invest in projects focused on Indigenous and Native communities, advancing opportunities for older adults to make an impact, through their time and experience
 - Allow funding of innovative programming
 - Demonstrate the power of senior volunteers to make significant contributions within their communities







How SDP Works



- AmeriCorps Seniors volunteers are individuals who are aged 55+
- AmeriCorps Seniors SDP assesses community needs and leverages AmeriCorps Seniors volunteers to meet those needs
- AmeriCorps Seniors volunteers serve at SDP volunteer stations in the geographic service area, including the sponsor itself

Rules and Regulations

A

- The Code of Federal
 Regulations is the source of the requirements that govern
 AmeriCorps Seniors grants.
- Viewable at <u>eCFR.gov</u>
- Funding and Grant
 Management Regulations: 2
 CFR 200 (Uniform Guidance)



Key Regulations



Service Activity Restrictions:

- Prohibition on replacing paid staff
- No political activity on grant time
- No religious activity

National Service Criminal History Checks:

- Specific set of checks for grant-paid staff required by law
- Be sure to budget for them
- Refer to https://americorps.gov/grantees-sponsors/history-check

Native Nations & Indigenous Elders Senior Demonstration Program





- AmeriCorps Seniors is accepting applications from eligible entities
- Applications are due by Wednesday, April 5, 2023, at 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time.
- Supports projects that focus on underserved Indigenous and Native Communities & engage adults ages 55 and older to address one or more of the Native Nations & Indigenous Elders SDP priorities.
