



## National Service in New Jersey



### MEETING COMMUNITY NEEDS IN NEW JERSEY

More than 7,300 people of all ages and backgrounds are helping to meet local needs, strengthen communities, and increase civic engagement through national service in New Jersey. Serving at more than 870 locations throughout the state, these citizens tutor and mentor children, support veterans and military families, provide health services, restore the environment, respond to disasters, increase economic opportunity, and recruit and manage volunteers.

This year, the Corporation for National and Community Service (CNCS) will commit more than \$15,700,000 to support New Jersey communities through national service initiatives. CNCS invests in cost-effective community solutions—working hand in hand with local partners to improve lives, expand economic opportunity, and engage citizens in solving problems in their communities. Serving in many of the state's most impoverished communities, CNCS provides vital support to schools, food banks, homeless shelters, community health clinics, youth centers, veterans service facilities, and other nonprofit and faith-based organizations at a time of growing demand for services. Through a unique public-private partnership, this federal investment will leverage an additional \$6,030,000 in other resources to strengthen community impact, build local support, and increase return on taxpayer dollars.

**AmeriCorps:** This year AmeriCorps will provide more than 2,300 individuals the opportunity to provide intensive, results-driven service to meet education, environmental, health, economic, and other pressing needs in communities across New Jersey. Most AmeriCorps grant funding goes to the New Jersey Commission on National and Community Service, which in turn awards grants to nonprofit groups to respond to local needs. Most of the remainder of the grant funding is distributed by CNCS directly to multi-state and national organizations through a competitive grants process. Other individuals serve through AmeriCorps VISTA, whose members help bring individuals and communities out of poverty by serving full-time to fight illiteracy, improve health services, create businesses, and increase housing opportunities, and AmeriCorps NCCC (National Civilian Community Corps), a 10-month, full time residential program for men and women between the ages of 18 and 24. In exchange for their service, AmeriCorps members earn an education award that can be used to pay for college or to pay back qualified student loans. Since 1994, more than 20,000 New Jersey residents have served more than 27 million hours and have qualified for Segal AmeriCorps Education Awards totaling more than \$61,580,000.

**Senior Corps:** More than 4,900 seniors in New Jersey contribute their time and talents in one of three Senior Corps programs. Foster Grandparents serve one-on-one as tutors and mentors to more than 1,700 young people who have special needs. Senior Companions help more than 800 homebound seniors and other adults maintain independence in their own homes. RSVP volunteers conduct safety patrols, renovate homes, protect the environment, tutor and mentor youth, respond to natural disasters, and provide other services through more than 490 groups across New Jersey.

**Social Innovation Fund:** The Social Innovation Fund transforms lives and communities using limited federal investment as a catalyst to grow the impact of nonprofits with evidence of strong results. It harnesses the expertise of grantmaking intermediaries to identify, evaluate and expand effective nonprofits and engages funding partners to contribute nearly three dollars to every one federal dollar invested. As the Social Innovation Fund network grows programs that work in New Jersey, more people are able to overcome their most pressing challenges in the areas of economic opportunity, health, and youth development. The Social Innovation Fund is investing \$600,000 in expanding the impact of 5 nonprofits in New Jersey.

The Corporation for National and Community Service is a federal agency that improves lives, strengthens communities, and fosters civic engagement through service and volunteering. CNCS annually engages more than five million Americans in service to meet local needs through Senior Corps, AmeriCorps, and national days of service; improves communities through the Social Innovation Fund, and leads President Obama's national call to service initiative, United We Serve. - This figure represents the number of awarded positions available to be filled in the 2013 - 2014 program year. For AmeriCorps VISTA, this represents the actual number of VISTA members in active service.
- This figure represents the maximum potential value of Segal AmeriCorps Education Awards that can be earned by AmeriCorps members serving in New Jersey. The award can be used in any state to pay for college, graduate school, vocational training, or to pay back student loans. The education award total is included in total CNCS funding.
- AmeriCorps National figures may include national programs headquartered in the state and/or operating sites of national programs that are headquartered in other states. Funding reflects the estimated proportionate share of the national grant associated with operating sites in this report. Some national organizations do not report operating site data, or it was not available at time of publishing, so figures may not reflect current conditions.
- New Jersey is served by the AmeriCorps NCCC campus located in Perry Point, Maryland. In the past year, AmeriCorps NCCC teams have served on projects in Camden, Union Beach, Toms River, Tabernacle, Hackensack, Colts Neck, Lincroft, Newark.
- The service location total may contain multiple counts of unique locations where multiple CNCS programs are operating.
- As part of its public-private partnership approach, CNCS requires grantees to leverage additional resources to strengthen community impact and increase the return on the federal investment. This figure reflects non-CNCS cash and in-kind resources that CNCS grantees and project sponsors have committed to raise to support their programming activities across the state.

# National Service Impact in New Jersey

## AmeriCorps NCCC

The Camden City Garden Club inspires and educates people of all ages by providing opportunities to improve their quality of life, health, and community through horticulture. The Club is a center to foster learning and community, while being a leading resource enabling community access to healthy, high quality, safe, and affordable food. AmeriCorps NCCC members tended seven existing gardens and started six additional gardens in Camden. In the process, members gained an understanding of how to build and nurture gardens and helped create additional community recreational and educational spaces.

## AmeriCorps VISTA

Based in Jersey City, Rising Tide Capital, Inc. provides support to women, minorities, immigrants, and other populations to start and grow successful businesses by investing in the entrepreneurial spirit that exists in distressed communities. In the first two years, AmeriCorps VISTA members have helped Rising Tide increase the number of clients served by 77 percent and have supported fundraising efforts leading to a 96 percent increase in revenue. Furthermore, the JPMorgan Chase Foundation committed \$150,000 to back the Start Something Challenge, a statewide initiative led by Rising Tide Capital through the support of VISTA. VISTAs have helped to develop, evaluate, recruit, and fundraise for this unique jobs initiative that will recruit and support entrepreneurs to start and grow businesses in marginalized communities across New Jersey.

## Senior Corps

Jefferson Park Ministries is a small community based organization that serves economically vulnerable families and young people by providing a variety of services in Elizabeth. The Elizabeth school district was classified as a District In Need of Improvement under No Child Left Behind. Jefferson Park Ministries' Foster Grandparent Program has made an impact on elementary children with exceptional or special needs. An opportunity not readily available within the school district otherwise, Foster Grandparents engage students one-on-one focusing on reading and math skills. Last year, 95 percent of students served demonstrated an improvement in reading participation and math skills.

## Social Innovation Fund

The U.S. Soccer Foundation is supporting the expansion and replication of Soccer for Success, a no-cost, after-school, sports-based youth development program whose goal is to improve health by arresting and reducing obesity through physical activity and nutrition education. In New Jersey, they have two nonprofit subgrantees implementing the program: Boys & Girls Club of Camden County and Boys & Girls Club of Trenton and Mercer County. These subgrantees receive a total of \$245,000 annually which they match dollar-for-dollar with nonfederal fund, and together they will provide 1,800 youth with physical activity, nutrition education, mentorship, and family engagement opportunities.
