Since 1994, more than 20,000 Indiana residents have served approximately 27 million hours and earned education awards totaling more than \$69.6 million.

Projects operate in communities throughout the state. The Service Location report contains a listing of all locations with national service. 2. The service location total may contain multiple counts of unique locations where multiple AmeriCorps projects operated. For AmeriCorps Seniors projects where 2022 service location data is unavailable, service locations associated with the project from the previous year are represented or are listed with no service locations. Projects may be headquartered in other states. 3. Completed participants reflects all AmeriCorps members who completed service in Indiana between January 20, 2023 and January 19, 2024. For AmeriCorps Seniors, this reflects all volunteers funded by grants completed during that same period. 4. The Education Awards figures represent the maximum potential value of Segal AmeriCorps Education Awards that could be earned by AmeriCorps members who completed service in Indiana. 5. AmeriCorps State and National, Foster Grandparent, and Senior Companion federal funding reflects the estimated proportionate annual share of the federal grant associated with the participants in this report.
